A. Qualification

> Status Eligibility

- 1. An individual of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China (R.O.C.) and who does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of the application, is qualified to apply for admission.
- 2. An individual of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following requirements and who has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years is also qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.
 - (1) An individual who also is a national of the R.O.C., but does not hold nor has had a household registration in Taiwan.
 - (2) An individual who also was a national of the R.O.C. but has no R.O.C. nationality at the time of his/her application shall have an annulled status regarding one's R.O.C. nationality for no less than 8 years after an annulment of R.O.C. nationality by the Ministry of the Interior.
 - (3) Regarding individuals mentioned in the preceding 2 subparagraphs, one must not have studied in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student nor received placement permission during the same year of the application by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students.
 - The 6 and 8 year calculation period as prescribed in Paragraph 2 shall be calculated from the starting date of the semester (Feb. 1st or Aug. 1st) as the designated due date for the time of study.
 - The term "overseas" as prescribed in Paragraph 2 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau; the term "reside overseas continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year. If the calculated calendar year is not one complete calendar year, their stay in Taiwan should not exceed 120 days within the calculated calendar year period. The only exceptions to this method of calculation are for those who fulfill one of the following requirements with written supported proof:
 - a. Attended overseas youth training courses organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or technique training classes accredited by the Ministry of Education.
 - b. Attended a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university/college of which foreign student recruitment is approved by the Ministry of Education, and to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
 - c. Exchange students, whose length of total exchange is less than 2 years.
 - d. An Internship in Taiwan which has been approved by an authorized central government agency, to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
- 3. According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or school, and does not hold a household registration from the time of his/her birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in the preceding 2 paragraphs after receiving the approval from the authorized educational government agencies.



- 4. An individual, who has both foreign and R.O.C. nationalities and has applied for an annulment of one's R.O.C. nationality before Feb. 1st, 2011, the effective date of this amendment, will then be qualified to apply for admission as an international student under the amendment effective before Feb. 1st, 2011 and will not be subject to the limitation as prescribed in Paragraph 2.
- 5. An applicant of foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, having no history of a household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.
- 6. An applicant being a former citizen of Mainland China and holds a foreign nationality, having no history of household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.


Educational Eligibility

Master's Program: A Bachelor's degree or higher obtained from a university or an independent college recognized by M.O.E. should be verified by R.O.C. representative office. Should the applicant holds a Bachelor's degree from a university in Taiwan, proof records are required to indicate that the applicant obtained the Bachelor's degree in Taiwan with an international student status.

Ph.D. Program: A Master's degree or higher obtained from a university or an independent college recognized by M.O.E. should be verified by R.O.C. representative office. Should the applicant holds a Master's degree from a university in Taiwan, proof records are required to provide to indicate that the applicant obtained the Master's degree in Taiwan with an international student status.

B. Application Procedure

Please visit Application Website and register for personal account, after completing the on-line application, choose way of submission of the application documents. **Application without online registration will not be accepted.**

After completing the on-line application, application documents must either be uploaded or be posted to Division of Admissions & Student Recruitment, Office of Academic Affairs. Mailed applications must be sent by registered mail and be postmarked on or before the application deadline. Applications documents may also be submitted in person to Division of Admissions & Student Recruitment, from 8:00-17:30 (Lunch Break 12:00-13:30), Monday-Friday. Late applications will not be accepted.

KMU will complies with the provisions of the Personal Information Protection Act of the R.O.C. government and relevant regulations. The personal information of the candidates will be used only for the purpose of student recruitment and statistical analysis.

C. Required Documents

1. Online Application forms including KMU scholarship application form

After filling out online application forms, print it out and sign then upload to the online system. Applicants may apply for up to 3 departments/graduate institutes, however, please submit documents specified for each program.

- 2. **The highest-level diploma** verified by R.O.C. representative office. (Chinese or English translation is required if the transcript is in neither of the languages aforementioned.)
 - a. Academic credentials from Mainland China: The Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China shall apply.
 - b. Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods adopted in Hong Kong and Macao shall apply.
 - c. Academic credentials from other areas:
 - i. Academic credentials earned at overseas Taiwan schools or Taiwan schools in Mainland China shall be regarded as the same as those at domestic schools with equivalent levels.
 - ii.Academic credentials referred to preceding 2 Items shall be subject to the Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education. However, academic credentials earned from institutes or branches established in Mainland China by foreign schools shall require public notarization in Mainland China and be verified and examined by an institute established or appointed by or through a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.
- 3. **Official transcripts** verified by R.O.C. representative office. (Chinese or English translation is required if the transcript is in neither of the languages aforementioned.)
 - a. Master's degree programs applicants should provide Bachelor's degree (or above) official transcripts of every semester.
 - b. Ph.D. degree programs applicants should provide Master's degree (or above) official transcripts of every semester.
- 4. **Financial statement** that shows financial sustainability for study in Taiwan, at least NT\$ 120,000 / US\$4,000 or proof of the scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization.
 - a. The bank statement shall be issued by the bank officially with the information of current balance and currency, and be authenticated by R.O.C. representative office in/near the applicant's country, or sealed and mailed to KMU by the bank directly.
 - b. Financial statements from a Taiwanese bank or a branch of a foreign bank located in Taiwan do not need to be authenticated.
 - c. If the bank statement does not belong to the applicant, a signed statement from the account holder is also required, stating the holder's relationship with the applicant and guaranteeing to cover the applicant's expenses in Taiwan.

5. Proof of Nationality:

According to regulations of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of the Interior, the applicants must submit their birth certificates, certifications of the parents and any document that shows their parental relationships, as well as the documents that certify the applicant's nationality:

- a. Photocopy of a valid passport or certificate of nationality
- b. Photocopies of the applicant's parents' passports or certificate of nationality
- c. Taiwan Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) (if applicable)
- d. « Forfeited Nationality Permit Certificate » issued by Ministry of the Interior for at least 8 years (for applicants who hold foreign nationality, and once held R.O.C. nationality)
- e. « Certificate of Entry/Exit Dates » issued by National Immigration Agency (for applicants both hold foreign nationality and R.O.C. nationality)

6. **Proof of Language Proficiency**

- a. According to the announcements by R.O.C. overseas missions, international students are required to provide English or Chinese language certificate for Resident Visa for studying in Taiwan, such as Vietnamese, Indonesian, Thai and Myanma applicants, etc.. Please confirm with the authorities concerned for application requirements.
- b. English or Chinese language proficiency level is also one of admission considerations for parts of programs. Please refer to "H. Admission Criteria of Each Program" for details.
- 7. A study plan in Chinese or English
- 8. Two letters of recommendation (in Chinese or English)
- 9. Other documents specified by the department or graduate institute
- 10. **Passport size photograph**: a close-up shot of the head and shoulders (no hats/sunglasses/tinted glasses) within the last 12 months
- 11. Self-Check & Declaration Form (as Appendix 1)
- 12. Application Checklist (as Appendix 2)

Note: Incomplete application documents will not be reviewed.

D. Application Fee

No application fee required.

E. Scholarships

Applicants of foreign nationality, pursuant to *Regulations for International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan* are qualified to apply for scholarships as follows:

1. The TAFS:

The TAFS (Taiwan fellowship and Scholarship) comprises 9 awards in 3 categories : Fellowships, Huayu (Mandarin) Enrichment Scholarships, and Scholarships for Degree. Approximately 1,250 grants are provided annually for undergraduate and postgraduate students as well as researchers across the world to study or to conduct advanced research/study in Taiwan.

To apply TAFS, applicants could refer to the Admission Guide announced in January or February every year on the website of Taiwan embassy in your country, or take a quick view on the FATS website: <u>https://reurl.cc/x5MRz</u>

2. TaiwanICDF Scholarship:

International students who apply for M. Sc. Program in Tropical Medicine may be qualified for TaiwanICDF Scholarship. For applying ICDF, please view on the ICDF website:

3. KMU Scholarships:

Applicants who are interested in KMU International Student Scholarship should apply it while simultaneously fulfilling the online application form. Every type of stipend includes different allowance as below:

(1) Type A: One year tuition waived, TWD 10,000 stipend per month, and TWD10,000 - 11,000 per semester for accommodation.

②Type B: One year tuition waived and TWD10, 000 - 11,000 per semester for accommodation.

③Type C: One year tuition waived.

Undergraduate students can only apply for Type C, Master's students can apply for Type C and Type B, Ph.D. students can apply for all types of the scholarship. Failure to follow the instructions above may affect the result of application.



F. Tuition & miscellaneous Fee

G. Reminders & Admission Notice

1. [According to Article 2 of the Nationality Act of R.O.C.]

A person shall have the nationality of the R.O.C. under any of the conditions provided by the following Subparagraphs:

- (1) His/her father or mother was a national of the R.O.C when he/she was born.
- (2) He/she was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the R.O.C at the time of death.
- (3) He/she was born in the territory of the R.O.C, and his/her parents can't be ascertained or both were stateless persons.
- (4) He/she has undergone the naturalization process.

Preceding Subparagraph 1 and Subparagraph 2 shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the amendment and promulgation of the Nationality Act.

- 2. According to the regulations of Ministry of Education, if the applicant has ever been expelled by any university or college in Taiwan under these circumstances (with drop-out records due to failure in conduct grades, academic grades, or being indicted guilty by the criminal law), the applicant is not allowed to apply to the university. Violation of this regulation will result in disqualification of admission regardless of the merits of the application.
- 3. International students applying for the initial household registration in Taiwan or acquiring naturalization or restoration of Taiwan Nationality during the period of study, will lose their international student status and shall be dismissed by the school.
- 4. No double identities (overseas Chinese students and international students): Applicants should decide with which status to apply from the very beginning. Those who study in Taiwan with double identities (overseas Chinese and international student) will have their recognized student status cancelled.
- 5. Undergraduate Programs are lectured in Chinese. Applicants are required to have adequate Chinese reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. Most of the courses of Graduate Institutes are available in English.
- 6. At the time of the registration, admitted students should present proof of medical and injury insurance documents which are valid for at least 6 months from the date of the arrival in Taiwan. The proof of insurance issued in a foreign country shall be authenticated by the 'Overseas Agencies'. KMU provides insurance application assistance to those who are not insured, and insurance payment should be made upon registration.
- 7. Admitted applicants, whose arrival exceed one-third of the first semester of the academic year, are not permitted to enroll. For whom that are unable to register by the registration deadline and would like to extend their admission status to the following semester or academic year must apply for *Request for Deferral Admission* with Division of Registration and Curriculum before the first day of class. Request-approved students are allowed to defer admission at most 1 year.

- 8. No application documents would be returned for any reason. Copies are recommended to keep personally.
- 9. The degree awarded by each department or institute would follow the format announced by the Ministry of Education, R.O.C..
- 10. Internship and Medical licensing examinations (Examinations for Medical Personnel) in Taiwan will be held in Chinese mainly.
- Applicants graduating in the current year may not have to submit the diploma in the application period. However, the diploma must be submitted during registration at the school.
- 12. Obtaining admission status of KMU does not guarantee the issuance of a Resident Visa. If there is any problem related to Visa issuance, admitted students themselves should approach R.O.C. representative office in/near the country.
- 13. Regulation regarding working in Taiwan: International students must apply for a work permit to work in Taiwan and are not allowed to work more than 20 hours per week, except during the winter and summer vacations. Students shall follow the Ministry of Labor of Employment Service Act. as well as the disciplinary action in accordance with the regulations of the KMU.
- 14. For other related information, please refer to the Ministry of Education Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, International Student Recruitment Regulations of KMU, and other relevant rules.

If the calculated calendar year is not one complete calendar year, their stay in Taiwan should not exceed 120 days within the calculated calendar year period.
