

【Registration for the Training Workshop of Panel Interviewers】

Notification of Personal Data Collection

According to the Personal Data Protection Act (hereinafter referred to as the PDPA), please read the Notification of Personal Data Collection during Registration for the Training Workshop of Panel Interviewers by Kaohsiung Medical University (hereinafter referred to as the University) in accordance with the provisions of the PDPA.

1. Organization Name: Admissions & Student Recruitment Division, Office of Academic Affairs, Kaohsiung Medical University
2. Purpose of Collection:
The Unit collects your personal data to handle administrative matters with respect to the training of panel interviewers, and is compliant with the specific purpose of the Personal Information Protection Act, including: Education or Training Administrative (109), Investigation, statistics and research analysis (157) and Public Health and Communicable Disease Control (012).
3. Classification of Personal Data:
 - (1) Type for identifying individuals (C001)
 - (2) Occupation (C038)
 - (3) Qualification or technique (C052)
 - (4) Previous emigration, traveling details (C034)
4. The time period, territory, recipients, and methods of which the personal data is used:
 - (1) Time Period: From the date you agree to participate in the event, to one year after the completion of the event or business.
 - (2) Territory: service area of the Unit.
 - (3) Recipients: the unit within the University that provides service in cooperation with the Unit, or the outsourcing organization that hosts events for processing, delivery, and other matters.
 - (4) Methods: the digital file, paper, and other appropriate methods that are compatible with the existing science and technologies.

5. Rights for personal data:

You shall be able to exercise the following rights with regard to your personal data in accordance with Article 3 of the PDPA: the right to make an inquiry of and to review your personal data; the right to request a copy of your personal data; the right to supplement or correct your personal data; the right to demand the cessation of the collection, processing or use of your personal data; and the right to erase your personal data. For the methods for exercising such rights, please contact the Unit.

6. You are free to choose whether or not to provide true, correct and complete personal data. However, if you refuse to provide relevant personal data, resulting in our failure to perform jobs associated with this activity, you shall not participate in the activity.

7. As provided by law, or upon a request duly made by competent authorities or judicial authorities, the Unit may provide personal data or other related data to relevant authorities.

8. Your consent may be presumed given pursuant to Paragraph 3, Article 7 of the PDPA if you do not indicate objection and affirmatively provide your personal data to register events after the Unit has informed you of the relevant information specified above.
