英文	1	(C) 為 <b>最佳答案</b> 。	原答案無誤
	5	只有(E)是 <b>最佳(Best)</b> 答案，(B)是可能(possible)答案，如放在原句取代 maxim 一詞時，意思易懂，但文句不順，既為 proverb，又說 sensitive 便是蛇足。	原答案無誤
	6	mechanical 原來本意有機械的含意，但並沒有 automobile 之含意，且在本句中，mechanical 作延伸意義(metaphorical)的解釋，只有(A)是 <b>最佳答案</b> 。	原答案無誤
	8	原句說冰河(glaciers)直逼赤道，表示不是全地球都是冰封，故原答案(D) <b>dominated</b> 為 <b>最佳答案</b> ，(B)covered 則表示地球全覆蓋在冰天雪地中，不是冰河時期的原意。	原答案無誤
	10	<b>最佳答案為(A)struggle</b> ,文意和 scramble 最接近，若用(E)hasten 代入原句，則主詞 museums hasten 太擬人化，而且不如 struggle 對情況描述的活現。	原答案無誤
	13	(A)為 <b>最佳答案</b> 。原句中的“Valley of Nile”隱含某種語意脈絡，故“alleged”位最適當的詞彙。	原答案無誤
	17	The answer is (D). Please note that the verb "enhance" means to improve the quality or status. Thus, the word can NOT be used to refer to protests.	原答案無誤
	18	The answer is (A). The best answer is (A) because the context of the sentence is a “poverty-stricken Africa.	原答案無誤
	23	(C) 為 <b>最佳答案</b> 。	原答案無誤
	27	(B) ‘Prepare for’ and ‘prepare’ something ‘for’ are both grammatical correct, depending on the context. The application here means ‘the interview’, so it should be prepare for ‘the interview ( see ‘a mock interview’ in the later part of the sentence). (D) Technically one is ‘admitted to’ a position in an institute. If we say ‘into’ then it assumes ‘physical’ admission into the place, like ‘walking into’. So ‘admission into’ is not the right usage.	(B) and (D) 均可
	30	1. Power could be a [COUNTABLE/UNCOUNTABLE] noun: a natural or unusual ability for doing something e.g. He has amazing powers of concentration. 2. Answer should be (A). The correct way should be: "As with Christian art....the goals of..."	原答案無誤
	31	在引錄的原文中，所說的是達爾文建立了他成為自然博物學家(naturalist)的身分和聲譽;自然博物學家而非名聲是文章重心所在。故在題目中(D) <b>field biologist</b> 是 <b>最接近 naturalist</b> 的釋辭，而不是(C)famous person。況且，達爾文出版專刊是建立他科學家的身份，而不是爭取做名人。	原答案無誤

	庭和小孩教養他決定離開大城市的倫敦。 <b>最佳答案(B)</b> 中 <b>educated</b> 一詞有 skilled 的含意(見 Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary 第 2 義)，與一般受教育的意義不同，又如片語中的 educated guess，其"educated"便與受過良好教育的意思沒有直接關係。故 educated farmer 不作受過教育的農人解釋。	
34	<b>答案(B)</b> 是在原引錄文中已清清楚楚的描述出來。此部份指達爾文在鄉居生活中交往的情形，遠離塵囂不交際應酬，但卻沒有和科學界脫節，他的畜牧農耕只是藉口過著優閑的生活，故答案不能是(A)，也不能是(C)和(E)。	原答案無誤
37	The answer is (C). NFL has not <u>really</u> shown <u>concern</u> because the organization had evaded the issue until the Congress started its investigation and consequently NFL <u>acknowledged</u> the link. An acknowledgement does not signal an expression of concern. The Congress of course has expressed deep concern; otherwise, it would not have held the investigation and hearings to explore the issue.	原答案無誤
38	The answer is (A). Please note that "punch" in the sentence should be used as a <i>noun</i> not a <i>verb</i> . The definition(s) of "punch" as a noun does not fit in this sentence. Therefore, the best answer is (A).	原答案無誤
41	The answer is (B) because "Some scientists <u>suspect</u> the virus has mutated" is just a speculation not a confirmation. The statement that there are " <u>more than 1,000 confirmed cases</u> of the birth defect microcephaly" certainly conveys the deep pressure for a pregnant woman.	原答案無誤
43	The answer is (B). As the underlined words in the following quoted passage show us there are still many speculations about the Zika virus. When the riddle is not solved, there is not any vaccine working against the virus. "Zika also <u>appears</u> to be linked to neurological and autoimmune disorders like the paralyzing Guillain-Barre syndrome, and experts recently determined that it can also be transmitted through sex—a first for a mosquito-borne disease. <u>Some</u> scientists <u>suspect</u> the virus has mutated and that is why it can now cause neurological problems, <u>while others say</u> these tragic side effects may have gone unnoticed for years."	原答案無誤
44	The answer is (D). Within the context of the passage, there is not any mention about blood transfusion. Likewise, " <u>birth defect microcephaly</u> " in the context of the passage is not simply limited to labor; it broadly covers the whole process of fetus development. Otherwise, it would not be termed as "birth defect microcephaly."	原答案無誤
46	(C)為最佳選項。用歸謬法即可判斷其他答案不合適。	原答案無誤
