A. Qualification

> Status Eligibility

- 1. An individual of foreign nationality, who has never held Republic of China (R.O.C.) nationality and who meets the following requirements:
 - (1) An individual has never undertaken studies in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student.
 - (2) An individual has not been given a placement in the current academic year by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students in accordance with the Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan.
- 2. An individual of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following requirements and who has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years is also qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.
 - (1) An individual who also is a national of the R.O.C., but does not hold nor has had a household registration in Taiwan.
 - (2) An individual who also was a national of the R.O.C. but has no R.O.C. nationality at the time of his/her application shall have an annulled status regarding one's R.O.C. nationality for no less than 8 years after an annulment of R.O.C. nationality by the Ministry of the Interior.
 - (3) An individual referred to in either of the preceding two subparagraphs shall meet the requirements stipulated in Subparagraph 1 and Subparagraph 2 of the previous paragraph.
 - The 6 and 8 year calculation period as prescribed in Paragraph 2 shall be calculated from the starting date of the semester (Feb. 1st or Aug. 1st) as the designated due date for the time of study.
 - The term "overseas" as prescribed in Paragraph 2 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau; the term "reside overseas continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year. If the calculated calendar year is not one complete calendar year, their stay in Taiwan should not exceed 120 days within the calculated calendar year period. The only exceptions to this method of calculation are for those who fulfill one of the following requirements with written supported proof:
 - a. Attended overseas youth training courses organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or technique training classes accredited by the Ministry of Education.
 - b. Attended a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university/college of which foreign student recruitment is approved by the Ministry of Education, and to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
 - c. Exchange students, whose length of total exchange is less than 2 years.
 - d. An Internship in Taiwan which has been approved by an authorized central government agency, to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
- 3. According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or school, and does not hold a household registration from the time of his/her birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in the preceding 2 paragraphs after receiving the approval from the authorized educational government agencies.



- 4. An individual, who held both foreign and R.O.C. nationalities and applied for an annulment of one's R.O.C. nationality before the date of effect of the February 1, 2011 amendment to these Regulations may apply for admission as an international student in accordance with the provisions in place before the amendment and is not subject to the restrictions set out in Paragraph 2.
- 5. An individual of foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, having no history of a household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.
- 6. An individual being a former citizen of Mainland China and holds a foreign nationality, having no history of household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission. However, an individual who plans to apply for School of Medicine, Post-Baccalaureate Medicine or Dentistry must have resided overseas continuously for no less than 8 years.
- 7. If an international student applied to come to Taiwan to undertake a bachelor's degree or lower level program in Taiwan and after coming to Taiwan stayed for less than one year for some reason then discontinued their studies or forfeited their student status, that student may lodge another application to come to Taiwan to study, but only one such re-application is permitted. However, if an educational institution in Taiwan where an international student was studying considers that their conduct or academic performance was unsatisfactory, or if the student seriously violated any ordinances or the regulations of the educational institution and the circumstances were serious and as a result, in accordance with the provisions of its regulations governing student awards and penalties had to discontinue their studies or forfeited their status as a registered student, the student is not permitted to re-apply to study in Taiwan.
- Applicants who wish to apply to KMU have to meet "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" promulgated by the Ministry of Education (M.O.E). For the latest information regarding the M.O.E Regulations, please visit the website "Laws and Regulations Retrieving System".

Educational Eligibility


- 1. **Undergraduate Program:** A senior high school diploma acquired from an overseas senior high school or a foreign or bilingual school in Taiwan shall be recognized by M.O.E. and verified by R.O.C. representative office.
- 2. **School of Post-Baccalaureate Medicine:** A Bachelor's degree or higher obtained from a university or an independent college recognized by M.O.E. should be verified by R.O.C. representative office.



B. Application Procedure

C. Required Documents

- 1. Online Application forms including KMU scholarship application form
 - After filling out online application forms, print it out and sign then upload to the online system. Applicants may apply for up to 3 programs.
- 2. **The highest-level diploma** verified by R.O.C. representative office. (Chinese or English translation is required if the transcript is in neither of the languages aforementioned.)
 - a. Academic credentials from Mainland China: The Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Academic Credentials for Mainland Area shall apply.
 - b. Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: The Regulations Governing the Examination and Recognition of Educational Qualifications from Hong Kong and Macao shall apply.
 - c. Academic credentials from other areas:
 - i. Academic credentials earned at overseas Taiwan schools or Taiwan schools in Mainland China shall be regarded as the same as those at domestic schools with equivalent levels.
 - ii. Academic credentials referred to preceding 2 Items shall be subject to the Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education. However, academic credentials earned from institutes or branches established in Mainland China by foreign schools shall require public notarization in Mainland China and be verified and examined by an institute established or appointed by or through a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.
- 3. **Official transcripts** verified by R.O.C. representative office. (Chinese or English translation is required if the transcript is in neither of the languages aforementioned.)
 - a. School of Post-Baccalaureate Medicine applicants should provide official Bachelor's degree (or above) transcripts of every semester.
 - b. Other Bachelor's degree programs applicants should provide official transcripts of every semester, including both **Junior & Senior High School transcripts**.
 - Arts of the programs evaluate the applicant's Grade Point Average (GPA), transcripts including explanation of grading system must be provided. If the explanation is not provided, the Score/GPA will be converted in accordance with KMU's Grade Conversion Guide.
- 4. **Financial statement issued within recent 6 months** that shows financial sustainability for study in Taiwan, at least NT\$ 120,000 / US\$4,000 or proof of the scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization.
 - a. The bank statement shall be issued by the bank officially with the information of current balance and currency, and be authenticated by R.O.C. representative office in/near the applicant's country.
 - b. Financial statements from a Taiwanese bank or a branch of a foreign bank located in Taiwan do not need to be authenticated.
 - c. If the bank statement does not belong to the applicant, a signed statement from the account holder is also required, stating the holder's relationship with the applicant and guaranteeing to cover the applicant's expenses in Taiwan (A template as <u>Appendix 1</u>: Guarantee of Financial Support for Admission).

5. Proof of Nationality:

According to the regulations of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of the Interior, the applicants must submit their birth certificates, certifications of the parents and any document that



shows their parental relationships, as well as the documents that certify the applicant's nationality:

- a. Photocopy of a valid passport or certificate of nationality
- b. Photocopies of the applicant's parents' passports or certificate of nationality
- c. Taiwan Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) (if applicable)
- d. « Forfeited Nationality Permit Certificate » issued by Ministry of the Interior for at least 8 years (for applicants who hold foreign nationality, and once held R.O.C. nationality)
- e. « Certificate of Entry/Exit Dates » issued by National Immigration Agency (for applicants both hold foreign nationality and R.O.C. nationality)

6. Proof of Language Proficiency

- a. According to the announcements by R.O.C. overseas representative offices, international students are required to provide English or Chinese language certificate for Resident Visa for studying in Taiwan, such as Vietnamese, Indonesian, Thai and Myanma applicants, etc.. Please confirm with the authorities concerned for application requirements.
- b. English or Chinese language proficiency level is also one of the admission considerations for parts of the programs. Please refer to "H. Admission Criteria of Each Program" for details.
- 7. **A study plan** in Chinese or English
- 8. **Two letters of recommendation** (in Chinese or English):

Referees are kindly requested to submit recommendations online.

- 9. Other documents specified by the department
- 10. **Passport size photograph**: a close-up shot of the head and shoulders (no hats/sunglasses/tinted glasses) within the last 12 months
- 11. Self-Check & Declaration Form (as Appendix 2)
- 12. Application Checklist (as Appendix 3)

E. Scholarships

Applicants of foreign nationality, pursuant to *Regulations for International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan* are qualified to apply for scholarships as follows:

1. The TAFS:

The TAFS (Taiwan Fellowships and Scholarships) comprises 9 awards in 3 categories: Fellowships for Research, Huayu (Mandarin) Enrichment Scholarships, and Scholarships for Degree. For more information, please visit the website: https://tafs.mofa.gov.tw/ or contact the R.O.C. embassy or representative office in/near the country.

2. Elite Scholarship:

Award: NTD300,000 per year

Qualification of Recipient: Be a lecturer/ Associate professor/ Assistant Professor/ Professor as career in Philippines, Thailand, Myanmar, Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Vietnam, Cambodia, India, Bangladesh or Laos. Applicants must prepare the certified documents of their job when submit application to KMU. The name list of recipients will be recommended by KMU and reviewed by M.O.E..

3. KMU Scholarships:

Applicants who are interested in KMU International Student Scholarship should apply while simultaneously fulfilling the online application form. Every type of stipend includes different allowance as below:

- ① Type A: NTD 200,000~260,000 per year (monthly stipend, accommodation coverage and tuition fee are included)
- 2 Type B: NTD 80,000~140,000 per year (accommodation coverage and tuition fee are included)
- ③ Type C: NTD 70,000~80,000 per year (tuition fee)
 Undergraduate students can only apply for Type C, Master's students can apply for Type B and
 Type C, Ph.D. students can apply for all types of the scholarship. Failure to follow the instructions above may affect the result of application.

G. Reminders & Admission Notice

1. [According to the Article 2 of the Nationality Act of the R.O.C.]

A person shall have the nationality of the R.O.C. under any of the conditions provided by the following Subparagraphs:

- (1) His/her father or mother was a national of the R.O.C. when he/she was born.
- (2) He/she was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the R.O.C. at the time of death.
- (3) He/she was born in the territory of the R.O.C., and his/her parents can't be ascertained or both were stateless persons.
- (4) He/she has undergone the naturalization process.

The provisions of Subparagraphs 1 and 2 in the preceding paragraph shall be also applicable to those under the age of 20 at the time of the amendment and implementation of this Act on February 9, 2000.

2. According to the regulations of Ministry of Education, if the applicant has ever been expelled by any university or college in Taiwan under these circumstances (with drop-out records due to failure in conduct grades, academic grades, or being indicted guilty by the criminal law, or seriously violated



any ordinances or the regulations of the educational institution and as a result, had discontinued the study or forfeited the status as a registered student), the applicant is not allowed to apply to the university. Violation of this regulation will result in disqualification of admission regardless of the merits of the application.

- 3. International students applying for the initial household registration in Taiwan or acquiring naturalization or restoration of Taiwan Nationality during the period of study, will lose their international student status and shall be dismissed by the school. However, students whose application was handled in the same manner as the admission procedures for domestic students and who apply for naturalization to acquire the nationality of the R.O.C. in accordance with Subparagraph 1 to 3, Paragraph 1, Article 4 of the Nationality Act is not subject to this requirement.
- 4. No double identities (overseas Chinese students and international students): Applicants should decide with which status to apply from the very beginning. Those who study in Taiwan with double identities (overseas Chinese and international student) will have their recognized student status cancelled.
- 5. Undergraduate Programs are lectured in Chinese. Applicants are required to have adequate Chinese reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. Most of the courses of Graduate Institutes are available in English.
- 6. At the time of the registration, admitted students should present proof of a medical and injury insurance documents which are valid for at least 6 months from the date of the arrival in Taiwan, or documentary proof of joining Taiwan's National Health Insurance Plan. The proof of insurance issued in a foreign country shall be authenticated by the R.O.C. representative office. KMU provides insurance application assistance to those who are not insured, and insurance payment should be made upon registration.
- 7. Admitted applicants, whose arrival exceed one-third of the first semester of the academic year, are not permitted to enroll. For whom that are unable to register by the registration deadline and would like to extend their admission status to the following semester or academic year must apply for *Request for Deferral Admission* with Division of Registration and Curriculum before the first day of class. Request-approved students are allowed to defer admission at most 1 year.
- 8. No application documents would be returned for any reason. Copies are recommended to keep personally.
- 9. The degree awarded by each department or institute would follow the format announced by the Ministry of Education, R. O. C..
- 10. Internship and Medical licensing examinations (Examinations for Medical Personnel) in Taiwan will be held in Chinese mainly.
- 11. Applicants graduating in the current year may not have to submit the diploma in the application period. However, the diploma must be submitted during registration at the school.
- 12. Obtaining admission status of KMU does not guarantee the issuance of a Resident Visa. If there is any problem related to Visa issuance, admitted students themselves should approach R.O.C. representative



office in/near their country.

- 13. According to KMU Study Disciplines, international students whose graduated levels are equivalent to the 11th year in Taiwan should take 20 more credits for graduation.
- 14. Regulation regarding working in Taiwan: International students must apply for a work permit to work in Taiwan and are not allowed to work more than 20 hours per week, except during the winter and summer vacations. Students shall follow the Ministry of Labor of Employment Service Act. as well as the disciplinary action in accordance with the regulations of KMU.
- 15. For other related information, please refer to the Ministry of Education Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, International Student Recruitment Regulations of KMU, and other relevant rules.

Applicants must have completed at least 3 courses (6 credits, 96 hours) in Biology, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Organic Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics or Calculus, not including experiment courses, with a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of B+ in all the prerequisite courses during the study period of the bachelor's degree used for applying; or applicant who submits a result from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) (**Applicant will need to submit a result from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) with total score at or above 480 since Academic Year 2023) (https://www.aamc.org/students/applying/mcat/) The diploma, transcripts and other related documents should be verified by the R.O.C. Representative Office in the country. (If the original document is neither in English nor Chinese, a notarized translation copy is necessary.) Applicant whose native language is not English must provide official proof of English proficiency with scores at or above the following levels: CEFR B2 Vantage TOEFL ITP543 TOEFL iBT72 IELTS 5.5 GEPT High-Intermediate TOEIC 785 Cambridge Main Suite FCE, or Linguaskill 160. The program enrolls potential applicants of diverse backgrounds, not be influenced by any political or financial factors, and not discriminate against the gender, place of origin and/or residence, and background. 	
Evaluation for Admission	 Evaluation of the GPA scores of the prerequisite courses. Applicant who submits a result from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) with total score at or above 492 is preferred. Applicant with enough Chinese proficiency and has passed Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) level 5 or higher (http://www.sc-top.org.tw/) (or other equivalent standardized tests) is preferred. When official proof of Chinese ability is unavailable, a letter of recommendation to certify that the candidate is equipped with enough Chinese proficiency to understand the lectures taught in Chinese is required. All documents submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs will be assessed by the Committee of School of Post-Baccalaureate Medicine for the initial screening. If necessary, an interview will be conducted via telephone or web. Accepted applicants will be notified individually after the evaluation is completed.

- (1) The term "overseas Chinese student" refers to a student of Chinese descent who has come to Taiwan to study, who was born and lived overseas until the present time, or who has been living overseas for six or more consecutive years in the immediate past and obtained permanent or long-term residency status overseas. Note that for those applying to study in the departments of medicine, dentistry, or Chinese medicine at Taiwan universities, the minimum required number of consecutive years of overseas residency is eight years.
- (2) The term "overseas" refers to locations or countries outside of Taiwan, mainland China, Macao, and Hong Kong. The "consecutive years of residency" is defined as Overseas Chinese Students staying in Taiwan for less than 120 days per calendar year. If the calculated calendar year is not one complete calendar year, their stay in Taiwan should not exceed 120 days within the calculated calendar year period.

I, applying for Kaohsiung Medical University in academic year 2022, have never possessed an overseas Chinese student status at the time of the application. **I authorize KMU to verify all of the above information provided.** After being admitted into KMU, if any of the information provided are found and proved to be false, I have no objections in accepting the consequence of having my student status revoked.
